## O&M and Capital Budge

#### **Fiscal Year 2024-2025**

The Board adopted both the O & M and Capital Budgets for Fiscal Year 2024-25. Following discussion, the Board unanimously adopted a balanced O & M Budget in the amount of \$1,365,700 and the Capital Budget in the amount of \$367,000. The Capital budget includes funds to continue the Tank Coating Program, as well as replace the Telemetry and Programmable Logic Controller Systems.

The Board of Directors unanimously adopted Resolution 2024-04 increasing Charges at the public hearing held June 2024. The new rates effective July 1, 2024 are as follows:

Plan a visit to Oak Bottom Campground, beach and marina operated by Whiskeytown Marinas LLC. The concession offers year-round camping and boat moorage/slip rentals at Whiskeytown and during the summer season offers boat rentals, a snack bar, hot showers, and a marina store.

Learn about why Whiskeytown National Recreation area is important enough to be included with Yosemite and the Lincoln Memorial as part of America's National Park System.

They offer ranger-led programs such as the ever popular kayak tours, day hikes, gold panning and special evening programs.
