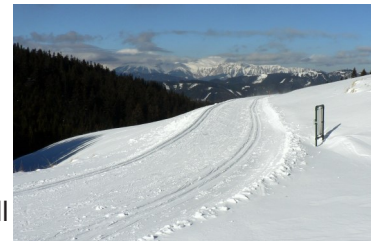
Board of Directors - Annual Reorganization
