How Much Water Have | Used?

If you are struggling with confirming how much water you have used here are useful tips to help you.

This is what the display on your meter looks like. Going from left to right, you will use the first four numbers as your reading. <u>Use only the first four num-</u> bers.

Under the Usage section on your water bill, you will find this month's reading "Current Read" and last month's reading "Previous Read". These numbers have two zeros added to them because the District bills in 100 cubic-feet (hcf) while the meter reads in cubic-feet. To determine how much water you have used, first remove the zeros from the "Current Read". Then subtract that number from the first four numbers on your water meter. See the example below:

Meter:0395 (1st four numbers)Current Read on Monthly Water Bill (less zeros):377Total Usage:18 (hcf)Add two zeros to the Total Usage:1800 cubic feet

The District's billing is based on 100 cubic-feet. All allocations are in 100 cubic-feet.

Please do your part and stay within your monthly allocation. As always, please contact the District Office with any questions.

Do I Have a Leak?

One way to check if you have a leak, is to look for the little circle at the bottom of your meter. A plus sign (+) in the middle of the circle indicates a leak. If you have a leak, but can't find where it is, there are two leak detection companies in Redding:

American Leak Detection: 530-378-1688, and

Precision Leak Detection: 530-247-5987, or

Call your favorite plumber.

If you believe you have a leak, but are unable to look at your meter, please contact the District Office. One of our field operators will be happy to assist you.



Centerville's Water Budget

2022 Water Year

Below is our District-wide projected water budget for the 2022 Water Year ending February 2023. As you can see from the table, our usage is trending higher than what was budgeted for March. In order to stay within our 1,050 AF water supply, we must begin conservation today! This overage in March will impact what's available for the remainder of this water year. Fortunately, April is showing an improvement.
