District Receives a \$10K Grant for An Emergency Office Generator:

The District happily announces the installation of an emergency office generator. This generator was purchased using a \$10,000 JPIA Risk Control Grant which was awarded to only five water suppliers in the State of California. This generator helps staff continue to provide a safe and reliable water supply to our customers during power outages.

Secluded Valley Pipeline Easement Clearing Project:

The District recently awarded a cross country pipeline clearing project to Dragon Demolition. The project will begin soon and is located northeast of Secluded Valley Drive. FEMA funding will offset a significant portion of the overall costs.

There is no set-up fee or charge associated with this payment method. To set up an Automatic Bank Draft, you can complete the ACH Auto-Pay Application form located on our webpage and return it to the District Office with a voided check or stop by the District Office and fill out the form.
